DATE, PLACE AND ROUTE

Art. 1. Tests that encompass

The XXIV Popular Marathon of Castilla-La Mancha, the IX Half Marathon Popular of Castilla La Mancha and the V 10 KM Popular of Castilla LA Mancha will be held next day 20 OCTOBER 2019 at Ciudad Real – SPAIN-

The LXXXII Championship of Absolute Spain of Marathon and the XXIII edition of the Marathon Championship of Castilla La Mancha will be jointly held.

Art. 2. Departure and arrival

The Joint Exit, will be given at 9.30 am from the vicinity of the Rey Juan Carlos Sports Center, Juan Ramón Jiménez Street, allowing a maximum time of five hours to finish the marathon, two and a half hours to finish the half marathon and one hour and fifteen minutes to finish the ten thousand. As far as the federated championships are concerned, the regulations of the corresponding federations will apply.

The arrival will be made on the athletics tracks of the Rey Juan Carlos sports center

Art. 3. Travel

The competitions will be disputed over the distance of 42.195 meters, the Marathon; 21,097 meters, the Half Marathon and 10,000 meters the 10 km. Circuits approved by the RFEA, which will run on asphalt, through the town of Ciudad Real. The test will be controlled by the Official College of Judges of the Community of Castilla la Mancha.

Art. 6. Registration dates and prices.

They must be made online on the website: www.maratonclm.net. The registration will be considered complete after making the payment of the same through the secure payment gateway of our website. Once done, a mail will be sent to the participant informing him of his data in the definitive inscription.

Registrations will not be accepted after October 15.

These prices do not include the Day License (€ 5 compulsory for marathon and € 3 for Half marathon and 10 km for runners who do not have the national license -RFEA-, regional license of Castilla La Mancha -FACLM- or license runner's plus, in force).

Regarding the Federated Championships, the provisions of the regulations of the corresponding Federations will be followed.

Registration fees will be reimbursed 50% in case of injury, after justification to the Organization by Medical Official Report, up to one month before the test.

In the case of suspending the race due to force majeure, the registration fee will not be refunded

INFORMATION TO PARTICIPANTS

Art. 8. Confirmation contact and correction of errors

The organization will only contact the participant to request any necessary information, report test matters or organizational variation.

Upon completing the registration, the organization will send an email to the athlete confirming their participation and the indicated data.

DORSALES:

Art. 9. Date to remove the numbers

They will retire together with the chip the day before the test, from 15.30 to 20.30 hours, in the premises of the old Casino of Ciudad Real, Caballeros street No. 3, or place that, at the time, is indicated.

They can withdraw the race number on the same day of the race from 7:30 a.m. to 9:00 a.m., at the Prince Felipe Sports Center, next to the start, only those athletes participating in the Popular Marathon of Castilla La Mancha that previously indicated it to the organization through the registration form.

Athletes participating in the Absolute Marathon Spain Championship must necessarily pick up the day before the race in the schedule above.

IMPORTANT: The bib number carries the advertising of the sponsors that contribute to the support of the event, therefore, it must be placed in the front and in a visible place. Any athlete who fails to do so may be disqualified.

CATEGORIES

Art. 10. Categories for the different tests

The XXIV Popular Marathon of Castilla la Mancha, the IX Popular Half Marathon of Castilla La Mancha, and the V 10 Km of Castilla La Mancha, will be open to whoever wants it, whether or not federated, without distinction of condition, nation or sex, as long as they have reached the age of 18 on the day of the test.

Only in the case of 10 Km, may participate also with 16 years old, with written authorization from parents or guardians.

Art. 12. Prizes in cash.

Art. 13. Brands to have access to Prizes in cash.

To have access to 100% of the cash prizes of the MARATHON general classification, a mark lower than 2h.25'00 "in the men's category and less than 2h.55'00" in the female category must be made.

In order to have access to 50% of the cash prizes of the MARATON general classification, a mark lower than 2h.35'00 "in men and 3h.10'00" in the female category must be made.

To have access to 100% of the cash prizes of the general classification of the HALF MARATHON, a mark lower than 1h.09'00 "in the men's category and lower than 1h.22'00" in the female category must be made.

To have access to 50% of the cash prizes of the general classification of the HALF MARATHON, you must make a mark lower than 1h.13'00 "in the men's category and 1h 26'00" in the female category.

The cash prizes will be awarded once the definitive classifications have been made public and once the results of the anti-doping control have been received, as the case may be.

For the Collection of the prizes, the winners must send to the organization, organizacion@maratonclm.net, their full name, a copy of the NIF and the IBAN of the bank account where the transfer will be made for the amount of the prize won. For this, they will have until the 15th of December, as the maximum date.

Art. 14. Local Category. Metallic Awards for MARATHON

Athletes participating or born in Ciudad Real will be entitled to the following prizes in cash in the Marathon event.

100 Euros for the first classified
75 Euros for the second classified
50 Euros for the third classified

In the local category there will be no trademark limitation.

Art. 14.1. Special prize for clubs

- The three clubs with the most athletes in the Marathon will receive a ham and a cheese.
- The three clubs with the most athletes in the Half Marathon will receive a ham and a cheese.
- The three clubs with the most athletes arriving at the Ten Thousand will receive a ham and a cheese.

The participants will register individually indicating the name of the Club they belong to.

The clubs, if they consider it appropriate, may submit to the organization a list of their participating athletes by October 1, indicating a telephone number and an email address for possible communications.

TROPHIES

Art. 15. Trophy will be given to the following classified:

Art. 15.1. Claims to the general classification.

All classifications are the sole responsibility of the members of the Judges Committee of the RFEA and the FACLM.

The claims that affect positions of the classification with award or trophies will be presented in writing, along with € 50, to the Referee within a maximum period of 30 minutes from the provisional publication of the classifications, which will decide. In case of giving the reason to the broker will be returned 50 €.

Other claims that do not affect prizes or trophies must be sent in writing to the organization's mail: organizacion@maratonclm.net to the attention of the Referee, before the Wednesday following the celebration of the event.

The Organization will communicate the resolutions of the Arbitrator, or those corresponding to the organization itself, within a maximum period of 10 days, from which the classifications will be considered final.

Art. 16. Obligation to withdraw prizes and trophies

It is mandatory to collect the corresponding prizes and trophies in the ceremony of delivery of the same. They will lose their right to those who did not pick them up.

ACCREDITATION BEFORE THE ORGANIZATION

Art. 17. Application for registration data by the organization

The organization may at any time request the accreditation of the data outlined in the registration form. The irregularity or falsification of the same will cause disqualification.

Art. 18. Accreditation of identity by the participants.

All athletes who receive prize money or trophy must prove their personality by NIF or passport if so requested by the organization.

MEDICAL CARE

Art. 19. Medical services

The organization will have specialized medical services in the places of departure, arrival and during travel.

Art. 20. Decisions of the medical services and judges of the test

The medical service of the competition and the judges of the same are authorized to withdraw during the test any athlete who, in their opinion, manifests a physical condition that may be detrimental to their health.

Art. 21. Identification for athletes with medical problems

Any runner with medical problems, such as allergies or others, may request from the organization a label with a red cross, inscribing the problem on the back and holding it in a visible place for more control and information in case of medical necessity.

Art. 21.1. Doping control.

According to IAAF regulations, doping control will be carried out on runners who are designated by the representatives of the AEPSAD. The runners will be presented to the doping control provided with a social identifiable document. The refusal to pass doping control supposes automatic disqualification for all purposes.

DISQUALIFICATIONS

Art. 22. Causes of disqualification.

Will be disqualified by the judges of the test:

- The athlete who does not complete the full course.
- Who does not wear a fixed and visible dorsal.
- Who alters the publicity of the number.
- Who runs with a dorsal awarded to another athlete.
- Who enters the finish line without dorsal.
- Who does not heed the indications of the judges.
- Who manifests a non-sporting behavior.
- Whoever refuses to pass doping control.
- Who does not have placed the chip delivered by the organization.

Art. 23. Loss of rights due to disqualification

The disqualified runners will lose all options to cash prizes and trophies as well as to be taken into account in the corresponding classification

REFITTING

Art. 24. Supply points and sponges.

There will be refreshment posts every 5 km from kilometer 5, and water points and sponges every 5 km from Km. 7.5; gifted according to standards established by the RFEA. and the IAAF.

Art. 25. Individualized provisioning

Athletes who prefer to do so must provide the kind of food or drinks they wish to take at the refreshment points, and deliver said request to the organization the day before the race during the delivery of numbers.

PROOF INSURANCE

Art. 26. Participation insurance.

All participants officially registered will be covered by a civil liability insurance policy, agreed by the organization, which will cover incidents that occur as a direct result of the development of the test and never as a result of a suffering or latent tare, recklessness, negligence , non-observance of laws and regulations, etc.

The organization declines all responsibility for the damages that the participants in this test may cause to themselves as to other people due to the aforementioned causes.

GIFTS

Art. 27. Gifts to the participants.

All registered participants will be given sports material and a bag from the runner with gifts when they remove the number; as well as bag of supplies to all those who arrived at the finish line.

The diploma and the arrival and career photos can be downloaded FREE OF CHARGE from the official website www.maratonclm.net days after the test.

All participants in the XXIV edition of the Quixote Marathon will receive, upon crossing the finish line, a commemorative medal.

DELIVERY OF TROPHIES AND AWARDS

Art. 28. Place and time for the delivery of trophies.

It will be held at the Rey Juan Carlos sports center in Ciudad Real at the following times:

V 10 KM Popular of Castilla La Mancha: From 12.00.

IX Half Marathon Popular of Castilla La Mancha: from 12:30 o'clock

XXIV Popular Marathon of Castilla La Mancha: From 14.00 hours.

IMAGE RIGHTS

Art. 29. Acceptance by participants of the transfer of data and images for purposes related to the activity.

The participants accept the dissemination, recording and distribution of images and videos taken during the course of the test and give their consent for QVIXOTE MARATON. ADAD, by itself or through its sponsors or third parties, will treat informationally and with exclusively sports, promotional or commercial purposes, their personal data, as well as their image within the test by means of photographs, videos, etc.

All runners accept the publication of their name in the Classification of the event, in the media and / or the internet, by registering.

In accordance with the Organic Law 15/1999 of December 13, the protection of personal data, the participant may exercise their right of access to these files in order to rectify or cancel partially or total its content. ACCEPTANCE OF THE REGULATION

Art. 30. Acceptance of the regulations by the participants.

All participants taking the exit accept and sign the Disclaimer of Data Protection and Responsibility Statement, assuming this Regulation and the RFEA and IAAF Rules. In case of doubt, the criteria of the Organization will prevail.

This test belongs to the Official Calendar of the Royal Spanish Athletics Federation, and through its registration the broker expressly consents that his basic data be transferred to this entity for the processing, before the insurance company, of the compulsory insurance of accidents and Civil Liability as well as the management of the day license and popular ranking of road tests. In any case and as established by the Data Protection Law, the interested party may exercise in the future their rights of access, rectification, cancellation and opposition by writing or emailing the Royal Spanish Athletics Federation.
